Qtn 1. WHAT MADE YOU COME TO BIBLE SCHOOL?

When I was in the Middle East back 1985 I started to attend Bible study there.

After I came back to Philippines, a Christian friend invited me to join in his Bible study. Every time he had a Bible Study I went with him until I feel that I like to share the Word of God too. So I looked for a Bible College where I can undergo training. I found Crusade Bible College (our previous name) and when my Uncle who is a Christian knows that I have planned to go in Bible school, he shouldered all the expenses of my studies.

No one pushed me to go to Bible school, no one told me to go to Bible school. It was God who put in my heart that desire.

Qtn 2. WHAT DID GOD LEAD YOU TO DO AFTER BIBLE SCHOOL?

After I finished Bible School year 1996, I got married to Marilou who was also a fellow student. Right after our wedding we prayed to God where He wants us to be.

God put in our hearts to stay here in Bulacan. Eventually we moved to Malolos 1998, to pioneer a church. We have Malolos Alliance Church for 12 years – from nothing to building and lot.

Qtn 3. LOOKING BACK HOW HAS GOD BLESSED YOU?

It's really hard to start in the ministry. But we continued even sometimes lack of basic needs. Many times other CAMACOP Churches invite us to be their Pastor and offer big allowance to us 4 to 5 times of what I receive in Malolos. But I did not accept their invitation. Then, God used people to give us a house, also an owner type jeep, a motor bike and even a lap top. We have 2 boys and a baby girl. God is faithful and He will do it!



Center For Disabled. It was a privilege last week, National Disability week, to be invited by the SM Mall management to help organize the program in our local Mall. All our SPED schoolers, 112 of them were involved. (deaf – 86, other disabilities-36) Leslie, our wheelchair staff was an emcee – a first for her! SM Malls really support Pwds. We are needing an Occupational Therapist.
