He had many financial hardships, but was able to finish his degree. He is happy and teaches in our high school.

The engineer's team rushed here early Friday. They pulled the pump up. To our horror we saw that the whole pump would have to be replaced. The water level had gone down and the motor had been overworking to suck it up. The engineer did a quick turn back to Manila to get an entire pump...and the cost of it all was P75,000! Praise God, we happened to have that! (a gift from a friend). If it had happened a month before, we wouldn't have had it! The new pump started at 2.00am. The function started at 8.00am!
